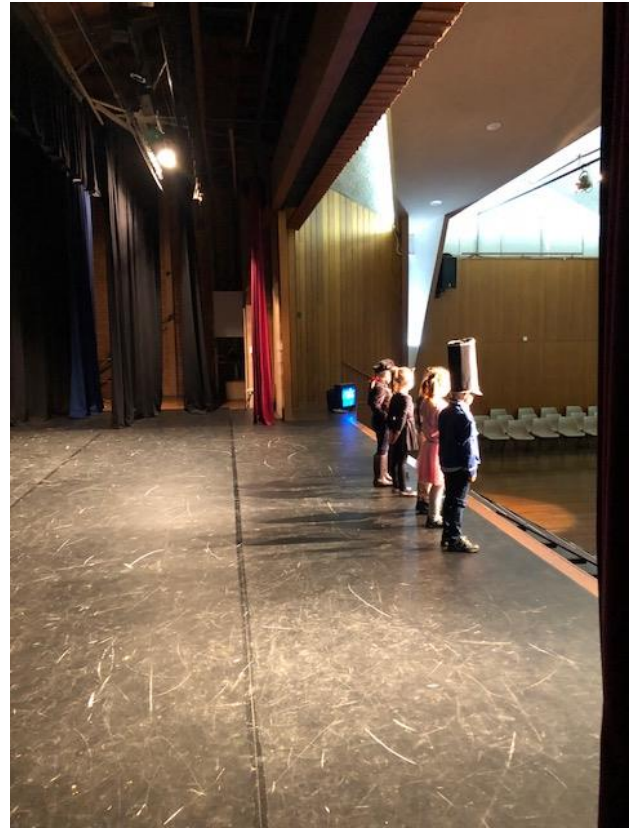

Click on your child's image & select your preferred background

Select your package (see all packages available by clicking 'view all')

If you wish to enter another child's code, just click "Change Shoot" at the top left corner.

Once you have completed your orders, go to the checkout.

All packages ordered before Friday 7th September will be returned to the School.
