### Revised Enrolment Policy

NSW DoE have released a revised school enrolment policy. As of day one, Term 4, all public schools will have an enrolment zone that must be adhered to. Each school is given an "enrolment number cap" based on permanent classroom allocations. Schools cannot take enrolments outside of their zoned area if they are close to or above their "cap". The department is also moving towards an online enrolment process in the future which will be linked to your home address.
