Our students have been eagerly viewing, discussing and celebrating the many old and new sports currently taking place in Tokyo. In the Classroom

K,1 Miss Cornish- This week in the K-1 class we are working on our Division by using blocks to group equally or counting backwards by 2's, 5's and 10's.

For Writing we are reading a book called Bones which talks about the different types of bones in humans and animals, students will use this information to write their own story.

In Science we are learning about light and the things it can travel through by using torches.

2, 3- Miss Nagle- This week in the 2/3 classroom we are continuing to develop our information report writing. Last week the students had a blast as they learned and wrote about the life cycle of stars. The students have been very engaged in each week's topics and are very proud of their writing when they publish it at the end of each week.

In Maths this week students are continuing to develop their division skills as well as their understanding of length using formal units of measurement. This has meant a whole bunch of fun hands on learning! In Science students have been learning about how heat moves between objects and how some materials are better conductors than others.

In History the students are learning about the Age of Exploration with a focus on Columbus and the impact his voyages had.

4,5,6- Mrs Mac- Our 4,5 & 6 students have been following the Olympics each day and completing a workbook. In English our novel studies on The BFG and Harry Potter & The Philosophers Stone are progressing with some wonderful wanted posters and Nimbus 2000 broom advertisements. In Math, Multiplication and Division problems have been explored, Maths Online videos have been used to support students' learning and helped to consolidate these concepts. Students have access to these tutorials at home via their Maths Online logins.

In Science students have been investigating Gravity as part of our Physical Forces unit. We have been experimenting with M&M rockets using bicarb soda and vinegar along with designing, making and testing parachutes.
